

SMALL FINDS

Trench 1

Layer 1 SF 1: Tiny fragment of glass (possibly Roman)

Trench 3

Layer 2 SF 2: Small cu alloy disc, probably a minim or minimissimi coin (Roman)

SF 4: Small metal alloy stud (probably post-medieval)

SF 5: Iron nail (probably Roman)

SF 7: Small peg with domed head of bone or ivory

Layer 3 SF 20: Silver coin of Edward III (1274-1312)

Trench 4

Layer 1 SF 3: Two vessel glass fragments (modern)

Layer 2 SF 18: Flint flake, debitage

Layer 3 SF 21: Small flint flake, debitage

Trench 5

Layer 2 SF 10: Flint scraper

SF 11: Small copper alloy repousse thin appliqué mount, with a kings head design (medieval)

Trench 6

Layer 1 SF 22: Length of copper alloy wire (probably modern)

Trench 7

Layer 1 SF 8: Cu alloy coin, George 1 (18th century)

SF 9: Glass fragment (post-medieval)

SF 12: Glass fragment (modern)

SF 13: Fragment of clay-pipe bowl (18th-19th c)

SF 14: Glass fragment (post-medieval)

SF 17: Glass vessel fragment (post-medieval)

Trench 9

Layer 1

SF 15: Cu alloy floral sexfoil mount (post-medieval?)

SF 19: Cu alloy handle with open rectangular end and remnant of possible iron blade/tool at the working end, probably post-medieval.
